

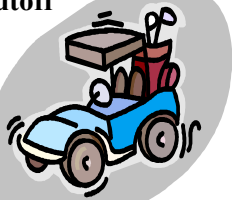


Golf Season Information

Mercer Oaks and Mercer Oaks East are closed during the winter. Mountain View and Princeton Country Club are open all year weather permitting. During the winter season call the golf shop for current conditions of the course. The course opening and twilight times vary at all golf courses throughout the golf season. Please call each respective golf course pro shop for the current schedule.

Golf Etiquette

Mercer County requests that each golfer help to keep the pace of play at a reasonable rate. Each golfer is asked to repair ball marks on the greens and divots on tees, fairways and the rough. Rake any foot prints in the bunkers. Non-metal spikes only. Proper attire is required at all times. Tank tops and cutoff jeans are not permitted. Golfers of all abilities should abide by the universal rules of golf etiquette.

Golf Membership

In order to obtain or renew a Mercer County resident golf identification card, one of the following criteria must be met to prove one's residency in Mercer County. All the following documents must be current. Fraudulent documents can result in loss of privileges at all Mercer County Park Commission facilities.

Criteria #1: Requires one of the following with Mercer County address as a proof of residency.

- NJ digital / photo driver license.
- NJ digital non-driver ID card.
- NJ digital boat license.

OR

Criteria #2: Requires two of the following documents and valid photo identification.

- Current property tax bill or tax statement.
- NJ Non-photo driver license.
- Any letter or correspondence (including tax bills) received from the IRS or state tax office
- Original lease or rental agreement showing your name as the lessee or renter.
- At least two utility bills such as current PSE&G bill, municipality water bill or sewerage bill.

Junior residents:

- Current secondary school report card or transcript containing your address. **OR**
- Official birth certificate along with proof of parent's residency.

*P.O. boxes are not acceptable as proof of address.

Mercer Oaks Golf Course is an 18 hole championship golf course designed by Ault, Clark and Associates which was opened to the public in 1991. The course is a part of the landscape of Mercer County Park and Lake Mercer. It is a links type course with large greens and bunkers. Through strategic design and careful placement of bunkers and other hazards, the course provides a good test of golf.

Mercer Oaks East Golf Course is designed by Ault, Clark and Associates which was opened to the public in the fall of 2003.

Mountain View is a mature, 18 hole championship golf course which was opened in the 1950's. Mt View is open year round, seven days a week. Open weather permitting, during the winter season. The course measures 6,220 yards from the regular tees with a par of 72. Mt. View is characterized by its natural terrain of rolling hills and valleys.

Princeton Country Club is an 18 hole championship golf course designed by William Gordon in the 1950's. Princeton is open year round, seven days a week. Open weather permitting during the winter season. PCC's fairways are totally tree lined and the course is divided by the Delaware Raritan Canal. Princeton offers play on a first come first serve basis. The course measures 5765 yards from the regular tees with a par of 70.

From the championship tees, the course measures over 7,000 yards with a par of 72.

A traditional 18 hole championship, links-style golf course featuring generous fairways, exceptional bunkering and contoured greens. From the championship tees, the course measures 7,182 yards with a par of 72.

Amenities: A grass practice facility with pitching and large putting greens. The course is ideal for players of all abilities. A full service pro shop stocked with all traditional golf gear, equipment and accessories. Mt. View is managed by a class "A" PGA golf professional who also offers professional advice on golf equipment and lessons. The clubhouse offers a snack bar & grill room for casual gatherings and meeting space for other occasions. For additional information call (609) 882-4093
